Discover:

Medieval Maidens: The Medieval times are also referred to as the Middle Ages. Visit Her Majesty Queen Dagrny and her Ladies at Faire and inquire about how girls and women lived during this time. What kind of work did they do? Did girls go to school? What did they do for fun? Girls enjoyed music as well as dance during the Renaissance. Join the Masquerade Ball on Saturday at Faire and learn several dances of the Renaissance Times.

Clothing: Find out about the types of clothing women and girls wore during the Middle Ages. You will see many different types of clothing while at Faire. Find the following classes of people by how they are dressed: Peasant, Merchant, Gypsy, Knight, and Royalty.

Play Time: Join in the Maypole Dance or try your hand at Archery, Bocce, and Fight or Yield.
